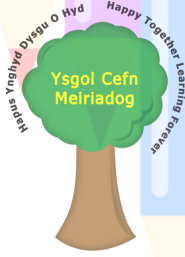

Work on the school building

During the holiday work was scheduled to be carried out to remove a small amount of asbestos from the outside of the building. This has now all been successfully removed but during the replacement of the guttering a bat was discovered. This has meant that all work has had to stop until the necessary checks and surveys have been completed. This means that the scaffolding and fencing across the front of the school needs to stay, we are unsure as yet how long that is likely to be. The site has been made as safe as possible in the meantime but I do ask that you prepare your children for the disruption and ask them to be very sensible when entering and exiting the building whilst the scaffolding is up.
