

This term we have a new topic, 'Dathliadau'. We will be learning about lots of different celebrations during the term. The children have already recorded what they already know about celebrations— which was quite a bit! We worked hard to make sure we listened to our friends whilst they were talking and sharing their ideas. Our focus for the next two weeks is birthdays. The children have been talking about the month that they were born in and we sang a song to help us remember the 12 months of the year. We will be creating a class graph to show us which month has the most birthdays. The children have independently been recording on a shopping list what they think should be at a party. Our Nursery children have learnt a new sound and made some new play dough—they counted the spoonful's as they went and waited for their turn. We also enjoyed swimming and gym this week as well as a fun Expressive Arts session with Mrs Smith, who is going to help us create a collaborative mosaic project to display outside the school.
