The children looked at different forms of energy and used these to help them create their pieces. Our Nursery children have had a busy week, learning a new sound, practising their name writing and counting sets to match the Spring numeral, they also enjoyed an outdoor learning session. All of the Discov<mark>erers are working so hard to learn tricky words</mark> and practise their writing skills, super progress is being made by all. Next week the children will be learning about a different celebration, we will be learning about Ramadan before our wedding prep gets underway! We hope you have a lovely weekend.







Investigators

The children have had a wonderful week and have been very busy in their topic work this week. They have continued to focus on the religion of Islam this week and have been learning about the celebration of the month of Ramadan. They have created Ramadan lantern sun catchers which are up on display on the classroom windows and have used their ICT skills to create a fact file poster about it on Adobe Spark. Yesterday afternoon, the children had a taste testing session in which they had the opportunity to try a variety of foods that Muslims eat during the month of Ramadan. These included dates, lentil soup, naan bread and vegetable samosas. Some foods were more popular than others!

The children enjoyed their PE lesson with Llio from the Urdd on Wednesday morning. This week they developed their netball

skills and enjoyed playing a small-sided game which focused on their passing skills.

Today, as it has been St. David's Day, the children have enjoyed taking part in some activities which celebrate the Welsh culture. They have sang some Welsh songs, recited some Welsh poems and have completed some tasks to find out who St. David is. Enjoy your weekend!
